Subject	Content		
-	In line with the national curriculum our children will be studying the following		
Literacy	We will be studying 'Quests' using the books 'Fortunately the Milk' 'East of		
	the Sun and West of the Moon' and 'George's Marvellous Medicine '. We		
	will also be studying non-fiction text types.		
Numeracy	We will be following the National Curriculum objectives in Numeracy		
	with a particular focus on the skills of addition, subtraction,		
	multiplication and division.		
Science	Electricity will be our first topic, where we will learn about circuits and		
	conductors. We will then learn about States of Matter; how different		
	materials change between solids, liquids and gasses.		
Religious Education	We are learning about the life of Jesus and who he is to a Christian.		
ICT	We are starting to learn how to use coding to write our own programmes.		
	We will be using multi-media to present our ideas.		
Geography	We are studying 'Water' this term: where it comes from; where it goes; how		
	it is managed in our environment; why it is so important.		
Art	We are linking art with our Water topic this term, looking at mixing colour,		
	painting and in particular the artist Monet.		
DT	We will be designing, making, testing and improving water wheels.
