The following information sheet will inform you as to what your child will be learning about this term. Any key dates and information for the term ahead can be found at the bottom. A reminder will be sent out nearer the time.

Subject	Content <i>In line with the national curriculum our children will be studying the following:</i>
Literacy	We will be studying <i>The Witches</i> by Roald Dahl – a defeating the monster story. This will be followed by <i>The Hook</i> – a suspense story!
Numeracy	We will continue to work on our times tables, as well as focussing on measurement and geometry.
Science	This term we will be learning about animals (including humans) and the human body.
Religious Education	RE will be focussing on the teachings of Islam.
ICT	Programing, coding and de-bugging.
Geography/ History	We will study the Vikings and Anglo-Saxons. We will study their art, lives and impact.
Art	In art we will be learning drawing skills in order to create a self-portrait.
DT	Taking inspiration from Anglo Saxon technologies, we will attempt to recreate traditional Saxon artefacts.
PE	In PE we will be doing athletics, tennis, rounders and cricket.
PSHE/SEAL	We will be focussing on relationships this term.

Homework will be given out on **Friday** to be completed and returned by **Wednesday**. Spellings will be tested on **Friday**. Homework will consist of spellings, numeracy, times tables and literacy.
