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Year 6 Curriculum information: Summer term 2017

The following information sheet will inform you as to what your child will be learning about this term. Any key dates and information for the term ahead can be found at the bottom.

Subject	Content
Literacy	This term we will be twisting the traditional tale of Cinderella and also reading Skellig by David Almond. We will be revising and consolidating our knowledge and understanding of spellings, grammar and punctuation in preparation for SATS.
Numeracy	In line with our mastery teaching, we will be looking in depth at Geometry and shape. We will also be continuing to build on our reasoning and problem-solving skills.
Science	We will be looking at habitats, including classification and working scientifically.
Religious Education	This term we will be continue to look at the plight of people across the world including refugees.
ICT	We will learn about computer networks including the internet and the opportunities they offer for communication and collaboration.
Geography	We will be carrying out a study of Japan and writing a non-chronological report on key aspects of the country and culture.
Art/DT	This will be linked with aspects of Japan, such as making Coi Carp kites and origami.
PE	This term we will be learning about multiskills (football, tag rugby, netball, basketball, hockey).
PSHE / SEAL	We will be focussing on relationships and growing up.

Homework

Literacy/numeracy Each Thursday your child will be given activities from the 3 workbooks for reading, maths and SPaG. It is to be returned completed on the following Tuesday. We please ask that ALL homework is to be completed in pencil.

Reading

Your child is expected to continue to read on a regular basis. Please help your child by hearing them read every night after school and by signing their 'Read & Respond' diary.

Spelling and Times Tables

Each week your child will also be given spellings sheets to be learnt for their test on every Wednesday and a times table worksheet to complete. It would also be helpful for them to practice their times tables at home to help them with speed and fluency.

PE

All children should have their PE kits in school for the weekly lesson. Year 6 now have two PE sessions each week, one on a Tuesday afternoon and one on Friday afternoon. It would be helpful if girls with long hair had their hair up on this day and if earrings were not worn.
