Year 6 Transition at Hestercombe Gardens Monday 2nd July 2018

This summer term, Year 6 pupils are taking part in a transition project based on the teen spy book 'Stormbreaker' by Anthony Horowitz.

The overall aim of the project is to ease the move from primary to secondary school. At primary, they will be learning the story in English and developing "spy" skills in maths, history, geography and science alongside all the Year 6 pupils from the Robert Blake Science College feeder schools. These skills will then be put to good use during their first few weeks at RBSC!

We have been very lucky to fund a special day for all the schools to get together for a "Spy Survival Training" day hosted by 1610 at Hestercombe Gardens, Taunton. This will involve a variety of outdoor activities in mixed groups from the four schools.

Please can you also send your child wearing sun cream and with a suitable sun hat.

If your child has free school meals a packed lunch will be provided. If not, please send your child with a packed lunch. Please also send your child with enough to drink (nothing fizzy please and no sweets).

There is no charge for this trip.
